Learning how to be a lady

America's Leaders camp helps girls ages 5-12 have manners, build confidence.

It's early afternoon on a Friday and the girls of America's Leaders summer camp are having a slumber party.

Smells of popcorn and nail polish fill the room as the girls roll out their colorful sleeping bags. Some, dressed in their Disney or Barbie pajamas, watch *Shrek*, while others talk and play games.

"This is all about fun," said **Miane Rison**, 6, of Weston. "We like playing with our friends and we have lots of fun with them. We watch movies and bring stuff to eat. We have a bunch of fun around here."

The afternoon slumber party is a reward for the campers, who learned two dances and six cheers, which they performed for their parents. Each week, they have a themed party to celebrate their performance.

"It's fun because you get to show them what you learned throughout the whole week," said **Rayven Grudin**, 10, of Wellington. "Sometimes it takes four to five days to learn everything."

The parents enjoy watching the girls' performance just as much as the girls enjoy putting them on. With digital cameras and camcorders on hand, they pile into the cafeteria at Chancellor Charter School in Weston to watch the show.

Like at any summer camp, the girls who attend America's Leaders have fun activities, but that doesn't mean they forget to say please and thank you in the midst of their excitement. Being polite while having a good time is the underlying theme of the camp.

Valerie Stuut started America's Leaders 12 years ago with the intention of having young girls be aware of manners and build confidence, through classes, while having fun.

"I felt there was a need for girls to be able to learn manners," she said. "They learn to say please and thank you, hold doors, and they learn to compliment each other. We get so many parents who say 'my daughter is shy,' and they are amazed to see the change in their girls by the end."

Their confidence level can clearly be seen with the members who come back year after year.

"I was here since I was 5 and I am 9 now," said **Paula Rodriguez**, of Weston. "I learned how to fly, base and to cheer and I feel more confident because I used to be really shy and now I'm not."

The modeling classes are more focused on good posture and being poised rather than on high fashion and makeup. The manners class focuses on behaving like young ladies.

"Our golden rule is to treat others like you would like others to treat you and when you make a choice think," assistant camp director **Sandra Lazo** said. "We concentrate on manners. We want the girls to feel good when they leave here."

As an incentive for learning, the girls are rewarded with "cheer" money. The money can be used to buy notebooks, bracelets, teddy bears and other products on Fridays, or can be saved for the auction that is held the last week of camp.

"I got cheer money because I was good and I used table manners," **Gabrielle Milian**, 7, of Davers said. "I got a little bear, (worth 80 cheer dollars), and this is my first week here."

The camp's weekly theme, ranging from shopping to vacation to imagination, is incorporated in the activities the girls do. During shopping week, for example, they made purses and scrapbooks with a shopping theme.

Camp directors at America's Leaders try to make it so that the girls, ages 5 to 12, always have something to do.

"It's so much fun," said **Megan Muralles**, 7, of Weston. "I didn't want to come to camp but my mom said to try it and I like it."

Cheerleading's new dimension

Now it's leadership as well as leaps and chants

Six-year-old Jordan Hunsinger handed 93-year-old Julia Ryan a bunch of pink and purple carnations, then nervously twirled her long blond hair.

"You were just darling," Ryan said to the young girl who had just performed a cheerleading dance with other campers for the seniors at Central West Adult Day Care Center. "I couldn't get over how cute you all were."

Hunsinger giggled and said, "It feels good to be here."

Hunsinger is a camper at a six-week summer cheerleading program in Davie, where girls ages 4 to 12 learn much more than dances and stunts. The days when a cheerleader spent most of the time jumping and chanting along sidelines are over. Modern cheerleaders aren't into the sport simply to lift spirits on the ball fields.

At America's Cheer Leaders, campers learn about community service, setting

goals and getting along with others. During the camp, they must donate five hours to community service and stay on their best behavior.

"It was sweet for them to bring us flowers," said Frances Potts, at the adult care center. "We just love to watch them."

Last week, between exercises and learning dance routines, the group of Davie campers made cards and arranged flowers for the seniors.

Jennifer DiPatrizio, 9, said she likes

performing her cheers and jumps for an audience. Alexandra Sultan, 7, said she enjoys making up her own stunts.

Valerie Stuit, owner of America's Cheer Leaders, said while the young people are having fun learning cheers, they also are learning how to act like young ladies.

"To be a good cheerleader, you have to be a good young lady, too," said 28-year-old Stuit, who came up with the idea for the program while working on her thesis at Florida State.

The cheerleaders advance to different levels as they acquire new skills and accumulate points for good behavior. They are given a different color ribbon for every level, ranging from beginning green to purple, blue, white, red and the top level, gold.

"There is so much more to this than being a good cheerleader," said Stuit. "We wanted a well-rounded program where girls could learn how to set goals and become leaders."
